



## MANAGER'S COMMENT

The Edge RCIS Matador Retail Hedge Fund returned 2.72% for August, relative to the SWIXTR index return of 1.15%. This brings the Fund's YTD return to 2.6%, relative to the SWIXTR index YTD decline of -1.8%, since March 2018.

The FTSE/JSE All Share (ALSI) increased by 2.3% on a total return basis in August 2018, whilst the All Bond Index declined by 1.9%. Cash returned 0.59%. The JSE Top 40 index increased by 2.4%, whilst Mid-Caps increased by 1.5% and Small Caps increased by 1.2% during the month. The performance of local equities was driven by increases in basic materials (5.6%), consumer goods (6.8%) and healthcare (11.3%). The worst performing sectors were telecommunications (-17.0%) and technology (-2.6%). Nonresidents maintained their net-seller position in relation to South African equities, with an outflow of R13.2bn during the month. MTN Nigeria's US\$8bn regulatory fine for alleged improper dividend repatriation forced the share price down over 22% for the month. South African government bonds decreased in August by 1.9%. Foreigners were net sellers of SA bonds totalling R19.7bn, bringing year-to-date sales to a total of R54.3bn. Yields rose on average by 33 basis points across all local government tenors.

From an attribution perspective, our equity long/short and multi-strategy managers were the main contributors to the solid performance. Overweight positions in selected resources, global defensive shares and property exposures were the best performers. Our fixed income manager slightly detracted from performance, as the portfolio had some directional exposure for lower yields. There were no trades at month-end.

Rising macro uncertainty, higher interest rates and a strengthening US dollar have led to a modest tightening of global financial conditions. This has laid bare vulnerabilities that had, until recently, been masked by plentiful global liquidity. Countries reliant on external borrowing to fund growth and large current account deficits, have suffered the most and remains the biggest risk. Competition for capital from cash-like assets has pushed up the compensation investors' demand for risk. This creates uncertainty in areas with weak fundamentals or political uncertainty.

### **INVESTMENT MANDATE**

The portfolio may invest in the participatory interests of hedge fund portfolios in any retail investor collective investment scheme; in any other securities (including, without limitation, derivative instruments), financial products and assets, subject only to the requirements of the Act read with the Hedge Fund Requirements. The Portfolio is permitted to invest in offshore investments. The Portfolio may invest in other portfolios of The RCIS Retail Hedge Fund, provided that neither the Manager nor the Investment Manager accrues fees in respect of such investment by the Portfolio in such RCIS Retail Hedge Fund. The Manager may create leverage in the Portfolio by borrowing funds, using short positions or engaging in derivative transactions.

# **INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE**

The objective is to identify and invest in a combination of underlying funds whose mandate is to seek out absolute returns. Whilst it is envisaged that the underlying funds will be predominately established and domiciled in South Africa, the Portfolio may, from time to time, subject to applicable exchange control regulations, invest in funds established and domiciled outside South Africa, where in the opinion of the Investment Manager, such funds will ultimately enhance the absolute return of the Portfolio.

**Medium:** These portfolios generally hold more equity exposure than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios.
